What's a great way to sharpen your game before the Regional? Practice your competitive bidding!

Competitive auctions are among the most difficult in bridge. Modern bidding uses doubles and cuebids quite frequently in competitive auctions, but the names and meanings assigned to these calls vary dramatically; it can get very confusing.

- What are all these different doubles - Negative Doubles, Responsive Doubles, Support Doubles, Cooperative Doubles? What do they mean and what do they show?
- Are any doubles penalty anymore?!?
- When do cuebids not show support for partner's suit? What else do they mean?
