

Cincinnati Bridge Center (CBC) - Covid 19 Exposure Protocol v2.0

This clarifies what we expect players and club owners/directors to do in the event of a known exposure to Covid-19 at the CBC. Other clubs in the Unit are responsible for their own protocol.

What Must be Done:

We expect members to be responsible so all may play safely. Players, directors, and club owners at the Cincinnati Bridge Center must be fully vaccinated and sign a liability waiver.

- No player should attend an in-person game if they are infected, feverish, or showing symptoms of Covid-19.
- If you are infected with Covid-19 and have exposed others at a bridge game, you must report the incident to the director of the game immediately. The director will inform the club owner (if different from the director) immediately.
- The club owner will immediately inform all players exposed at the game (by email or phone as necessary) as to the date and session of the exposure. The club owner also informs all sanction holders of active in-person clubs in the greater Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky area, and the President and Secretary of the Unit. The notice shall include language urging affected players to follow CDC Guidelines for handling known exposures to covid-19.
- The club owner or director must not identify the infected player in any way. We respect everyone's right to privacy.

In addition, we recommend:

- Each individual who was exposed to Covid-19 do the right thing to minimize risk to others.
- All exposed players follow the CDC guidelines for vaccinated people. Currently this means wearing a mask for 10 days after exposure.
- All exposed players get a covid-19 test after 5 days of exposure or at the onset of symptoms.
- All infected players follow the CDC guidelines to decide when to return to in-person games safely. You should be symptom-free and should wear a mask if within 5 days of your first day free from fever.
- Any decision to suspend a game for covid-19 is the responsibility of the club owner.
- Any decision to post a general notice of the exposure to a website is the decision of the club owner.
